Poster Guidelines

On-site Presentation

A 250cm (H) x 90cm (W) bulletin board, a sign indicating your paper number, and push-pins will be provided in the Exhibition Hall A. Poster presenters are to post their presentations on their assigned boards. Please note that Poster Presenters will not be allowed on the Exhibit Floor prior to the Exhibit opening to set-up their posters. Presenters are to be by their boards during their assigned poster session:

Posters must be removed from boards at the end of their poster session.

Digital Poster

Presenters provide a one-page Poster Image file. Please note that live participation in Q&A during the poster session may be held by each technical professional conference. You will be notified individually by the participating technical professional conference.

Poster Image file Requirements

Note: your Poster Image should be one page only.

All poster presenters should provide a one-page Image.

- Please send your poster file to the Confit system by 11 April.
- Name your poster file using your presentation number.
- While we do not have a specific template, there are a number of websites that offer free templates to assist you in creating your Poster Image. The size, 1120 mm x 1120 mm, which is slightly modified from A0 (1189

mm x 841 mm) will properly fit to a PC screen for presentation.

- Your poster should include:
 - The paper title and all authors at the top of the poster
 - A brief introduction, goals, experimental detail, conclusions, and references, presented in a logical and clear sequence
 - Explanation for each graph, picture, and table
- File type/size, Fonts, and Color:
 - The Image file size must be less than 10 MB
 - Use easily-read type. Suggested minimum font sizes:
 - Title: 36 point type
 - List of authors: 25 point type
 - Body copy should be double-spaced text: 15 point type
 - Choose your color to provide strong contrast and avoid pairing red and green elements to assist those who red-green color blindness
