

OPIC2026 Submission Guideline

By submitting an abstract, I agree to the following conditions:

An author or coauthor (including plenary, keynote, invited, oral, and poster presenters) will:

- Attend the conference in person
- Make the presentation as scheduled in the program
- Submit a 35-word abstract
- Submit a summary in specified format¹⁾
- Obtain funding for their registration fees, travel, and accommodations through their sponsoring organizations, independent of OPIC

Submit Summary Papers Online:

- Manuscript instructions are available. Please refer to templates in each conference.
- Summary in specified format must be submitted via the online submission web system in PDF format. Do NOT use E-mail or fax.
- If you have already chosen a Specialized International Conference to submit to, return to the previous page and click the “Submit your Papers Online” link.
- If you haven’t yet chosen a Specialized International Conference to submit to, browse to locate conferences. Once you choose a conference, click “Submit your Papers Online” from the submission page.
- The 35-word abstract should be a brief summary of the paper topic. This is a very strict word limit: DO NOT EXCEED 35 words. If the paper is accepted, this abstract will be included in the OPIC 2026 conference program.
- Only original material should be submitted.
- Papers should contain enough detail to clearly convey the approach and the results of the research.
- Commercial papers, papers with no new research/development content, and papers where supporting data or a technical description cannot be given for proprietary reasons will not be accepted for presentation in this conference.
- Please do not submit the same or similar abstracts to multiple conferences.

Review, Notification, and Program Placement Information

- To ensure a high-quality conference, all submissions will be assessed by the Specialized International Conference Chairs/Editors for technical merit and suitability of the content.
- Specialized International Conference Chairs/Editors reserve the right to reject any submission that does not meet expectations for technical content or topical scope.
- Specialized International Conference Chairs/Editors may require manuscript revision before approving publication and reserve the right to reject any paper that does not meet acceptable

standards for scientific publication.

- Specialized International Conference Chair/Editor decisions on whether to allow publication of a summary manuscript is final.
- The Contact Author will receive notification of acceptance and presentation details by e-mail no later than 1st February 2026.
- Final placement in an oral or poster session is subject to the Chair's discretion.
