Prospective authors must submit a one-page camera-ready abstract including figures and references. The abstract must be submitted via this web page (<http://www.cse.cuhk.edu.hk/~csse2014/>). **Only pdf-file format is acceptable.** Pages will be reproduced in the same size on A4-size papers. Each abstract submission must be accompanied with online author registration in the conference website.

Use A4-size and set all margins to 25 mm. Abstracts must begin with the title, authors' names (the presenting author should be underlined), affiliation and e-mail address of the corresponding author, all centered. 10 pt Times New Roman (Windows), Times (Macintosh), or other equivalent fonts should be used except for 12 pt boldfaced fonts for the title. The main text should be fully justified and be single-spaced. **The page length must be one page including figures.**

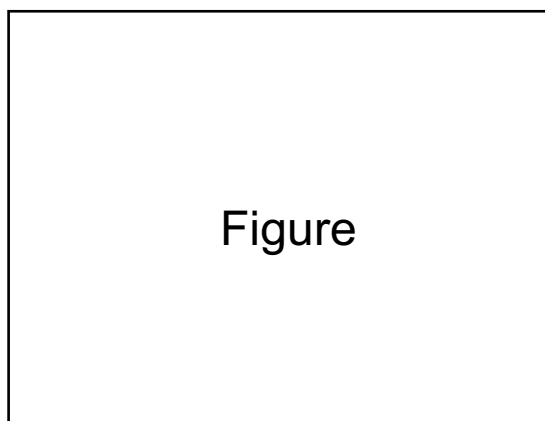


Fig. 1: Figure caption.
